basic it reveals the norms

by which men live in a
particular political culture.
In dealing directly with
the universe of
governmental activity,
Wildavsky uses reliable
accounts of how
budgeting is carried on to

national political life. The
focus is explicitly
comparative. After
developing a general
theory of budgeting; he
analyzes four rich
countries - Britain, France,
Japan, and the United
States, followed by poor
countries, American cities,
and American states.
Wildavsky uses this
analysis to develop and
apply a cultural theory of
budgeting, explaining the
degree of balance
between revenue and
expenditure; why
government grows in all
industrial democracies,
and why there are still
different rates of growth
in spending. He offers a
critical evaluation of the
first edition, linking the
ability of nations to make
history and the various
strategies of change they
adopt to explain a wider
range of budgetary
processes.
