They are the most severe and chronic form of learning difficulty in children. They can be present at birth or acquired as a result of illness, exposure to toxins, poor nutrition, medical treatment, sociocultural deprivation, or injury.

Learning problems typically consist in failure to acquire reading, writing, or math skills, which are traditionally considered core domains.
