This was also a year of debt forgiveness for zero-interest charitable loans. These were seed laws and they applied to Israel, based on Israel's conquest of the land under Joshua. Chapter 24 is on the jubilee land laws. In year 49, the heirs of the original conquest

generation were to be given their share of the family rural land. The judicial basis of the jubilee laws was the military conquest of the land under Joshua. It never applied to Jews living outside the land. Chapter 25 deals with economic oppression. It was illegal to use the state to oppress people economically. Chapter 26 is on the food miracles: the triple crop in year 48. Chapter 27 is on the right of redemption.
