The career of the German-American painter and educator Hans Hofmann (1880–1966) describes the arc of artistic modernism from pre-World War I Munich and Paris to mid twentieth-century

Subsequent chapters present a detailed analysis of Hofmann's materials and techniques and explore the relationship of the artist's mature palette to shifts in the style and aging characteristics of his paintings. The book concludes with lessons for the conservation of modernist paintings generally, and particularly those that incorporate both traditional and modern paint media. This book will be of value to conservators, art historians, conservation scientists, and general readers with an interest in modern art.
