It arranges under article type a huge number of works from scholars across numerous fields — reflecting the interdisciplinary and controversial nature of Deconstruction. The substantial introduction and annotations also make this bibliography, in part, a critical guide

and as such will make a highly useful reference tool for those studying his philosophy.

To what extent does geography remain an

important determinant of comparative advantage and factor incomes in resource markets?
