The Spandakarikas are a number of verses that serve as a sort of commentary on the Siva-sutras. According to Saivagama, the divine consciousness is not simply cold, inert intellection. It is rather spanda, active, dynamic, throbbing with life, creative pulsation. In Siva-sutras, it is the prakasa aspect of the divine that is emphasized; in Spandakarikas, it is the vimarsa aspect that is emphasized. Together, these two books give us an integral view of Saiva philosophy. Ksemaraja has written a commentary on Spandakarikas, titled Spanda-nirnaya. He is fond of sesquipedalian compounds, long and windy sentences, but he is very profound in the comprehension of the subject and so cannot be ignored. The author tried to provide a readable translation of both the karikas and the Spanda-nirnaya commentary. Each karika (verse) is given both in Devanagari and Roman script, followed by its translation in English. This is followed by Ksemaraja's commentary in Sanskrit. Then follows an English translation of the commentary. After this, copious notes are added on important and technical words. Finally, a running exposition of each karika in the author's own words is given.

This is the first translation with commentary of selections from The Zohar, the major text of the Kabbalah, the Jewish mystical tradition. This work was written in 13th-century Spain by Moses de Leon, a Spanish scholar.

Entsprechend dem Wesen der Glasperlenspiele, in dem sich verschiedene Struktursysteme wie der kabbalistische Lebensbaum, die Astrologie und die Chakrenlehre mühelos zusammenfügen, führt diese Suche auch zur

Entdeckung derselben Strukturen im menschlichen Bewußtsein un in den Gesetzen der Physik, in den Berichten von Nahtod-Erlebnissen und Berichten von Erinnerungen an die Zeit vor der eigenen Geburt und Zeugung, sowie in vielen anderen Bereichen.

Hierbei kann man breit gefächert in die Tiefe der jeweiligen Gebiete gehen, da für alle Tarotkarten und alle geomantischen Figuren Deutungstexte vorhanden sind. Es wird alles in diesem Werk erklärt und mit vielen Beispielen versehen, sodass man auch wahrlich praktisch arbeiten kann. Hierdurch wird dem Leser die Chance gegeben, selbst zu erkunden, welche der beiden Divinationsmethoden den eigenen Fähigkeiten zuarbeitet. Die Divination ist hierbei eine wahre Kunst, eine Kunst, die sich mit wachsender Praxis immer mehr und mehr entfalten kann. Ein zusätzliches Augenmerk ist auf die Verknüpfung des Tarot mit der KABBALAH bzw. mit dem LEBENSBAUM (ETZ CHAJIM) gelegt worden. Hier werden die einzelnen Zuordnungen aller Karten getroffen, damit der Leser nachvollziehen kann, welche Verbindungen man zwischen dem recht jungen Tarot und der uralten Kabbalah knüpfen kann. So wird hier natürlich auch ein kleiner Zugang in den Bereich der Kabbalah eröffnet, sodass man die Grundzüge verwenden kann, um via Tarotkarten auch kabbalistisch zu agieren. Die Zuordnungen sind so gewählt, dass man einen sehr klassischen "Heldenweg" erfahren wird, wodurch die Nachvollziehbarkeit immens wächst. Da die Tarotkarten aber auch eigenständige Energien beinhalten, ist eine Arbeit verfasst worden, dass man sie auch meditativ und sogar selbstinitiatorisch erfahren kann.
