Muslims believe that thousands of years ago prophet Ibrahim (AS) was told by Allah to travel towards a desert land (now known as Makkah) with his wife Hajar (AS) and his infant son Isma'il (AS). He was told to leave them in this area and, although they were not sure why, they had faith that this was part of Allah's bigger plan. The Sa'ee part within the Islamic pilgrimage at Makkah remembers Hajar's (AS) struggle to find water and help in the desert once Prophet Ibrahim (AS) had left them. The story is based on a Hadith narrated by Ibn Abbas, one of Prophet Muhammad's (SAW) cousins. Sahih al-Bukhari 3365.
