Genome-wide association (GWA) studies, as a prototype of large-scale OMICs studies, have

advanced our understanding of the genetic basis of many common diseases. With respect to

coronary artery disease (CAD) and cardiovascular risk factors, like lipids, blood pressure or BMI, they
