Bob Marley first became well known in the UK and USA in 1977, with the release of his 'Exodus' album. Living and touring as an international star for the next four years, he died twenty-five years ago, at just 36 years of age. What is less well known is that Marley signed his record deal in 1972, by which time he had 10 years' worth of recordings behind him.
