This book constitutes the refereed proceedings of the 20th International Conference on Group

Decision and Negotiation, GDN 2020, which was planned to be held in Toronto, ON, Canada, during

June 7-11, 2020. The conference was cancelled due to the Coronavirus pandemic. Nevertheless, it

was decided to publish the proceedings, because the review process had already been completed

at the time the cancellation was decided. The field of Group Decision and Negotiation focuses on

decision processes with at least two participants and a common goal but conflicting individual

goals. Research areas of Group Decision and Negotiation include electronic negotiations,

The Abbey of Solesmes, in the Sarthe region of Western France, is famous above all for its

plainchant and the contribution it has made to liturgical renewal, extending its influence far

beyond the monastery walls. It has also been at the forefront of spiritual renewal in the 19th and

settled on the island at Ryde, where a community of the Solesmes Congregation flourishes, to

which the editor of this book belongs."
